- Entering this competition constitutes acknowledgement that current PCA & PCV rules apply and acceptance of these rules.
- Neither the organizing committee of this competition nor the PCV accepts any responsibility whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground spectators or any other person or property.
- 3. Current PCV/PCA National Gear Check rules must be adhered to. Gear check required for all riders before competing as per the current PCA Gear Rules. The responsibility to ride in the correct competition gear remains with the competitor. If any judge or official discovers a competitor riding with incorrect competition gear, elimination may occur.
- 4. All Non-Pony Club members, and any Pony Club member who cannot show their Pony Club card or prove Pony Club membership must complete the day participant waiver and liability declaration: Non-Pony Club members and PCA/PCV members who cannot prove their PCA/PCV membership must pay \$20 per day of participation unless exempt by way of holding insurance (as per Page 4 -Liability Declaration) with an equine organization or hold their own insurance. PLEASE BRING THE COMPLETED FORM WITH YOU ON THE DAY. If we need to supply a form for you, there may be a cost. Day participants must provide the relevant form to the organising committee BEFORE riding on the day of the competition/activity on penalty of elimination. https://www.ponyclubvic.org.au/wp-content/uploads/2023/01/Day-Participant-Event-Waiver-and-Liability-Declaration-2023.pdf
- 5. **PCV Insurance Policy** specifically states anyone not following PCV Rules may be left uninsured.
- 6. **Refunds** All refunds are subject to a \$5 administration fee.
- 7. **The organizing committee** reserves the right to cancel any class or competition; divide any class; alter times; refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.
- 8. **PCV club member cards:** Membership Cards: PCV membership cards must be inspected at the office before riding, on the day of the competition/activity on penalty of elimination. In accordance with PCV Bylaw 15.7.a .ii Grading must not be corrected or altered at a competition.
- 9. **Queries, protests, horse abuse rules**: All queries and protests must be lodged via the completion query form as per the current PCV Handbook of By-Laws. Forms will be available at the office.
- 10. **No Dogs Allowed** Exemption allowed with organizing committees approval.
- 11. PCV Alcohol & Smoking Policy apply.
- 12. **No stallions, colts or rigs** or mares with foals at foot. Horses must be at least 4 years of age on the day of the competition.
- 13. **Presentations:** will occur after scores have been posted for 30 minutes.
- 14. **Riders who do not stay for presentation MUST** provide \$3.00 for an envelope & postage and provide address details on the day or they will forfeit their prize/ribbon.
- 15. Scoring: equality of scores will be separated as per the current PCV Handbook of Bylaws.
- 16. **PCV lunging policy applies. Lunging:** is permitted in enclosed arena. Riders need to be considerate of other riders needing to use the round yard and not use arena for more than 10 min if there are riders waiting.
- 17. **Event Waiver and Liability Declaration:** Entries must be accompanied by a signed and completed Individual Member Event Waiver and Liability Declaration for each entrant. The Individual Member Event Waiver and Liability Declaration must be signed by the entrant.
- 18. Freshman's: Strictly a maximum of 5 rounds per horse.

Liability Declaration Form: All open Riders will be required to complete a Liability Declaration Form when entering and email it to MDHPC and pay \$20.00 if unable to provide proof that they are current financial members of the organizations.


